Entry Requirements: Applicants must have

- (i) Six passes at the General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) (G.C.E. - O/L) examination with four credits in one and the same sitting;
Or
(ii) Completion of the National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) Level - 3 or any other academic qualification which is equivalent to the G.C.E. (O/L) examination, as acceptable to the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Law and the Senate of the University of Colombo
Or
(iii) Successful completion of any other relevant Certificate/Advanced Certificate/Diploma/Higher Diploma offered by the University of Colombo or any other University/Institute recognized by the University Grants Commission of Sri Lanka
And
2. Possess at least an ordinary pass (S) for English at the G.C.E. (O/L) examination or ordinary pass for General English at the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination and satisfactory performance at the interview.
