*Applications for the entry of the diploma will be issued by the Department of Linguistics from 22.05.2022 to 24.06.2022.

*The objective of the programme is to provide candidates with the necessary knowledge and practice required in professional translation/ interpretation.

Diploma in Translation Course:

- I. Tamil-Sinhala Translation Diploma (for candidates who have skills in Sinhala and Tamil)
- II. English-Sinhala Translation Diploma (for candidates who have skills in English and Sinhala)

COURSE DURATION: One academic year. Lectures will be held on Saturdays from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm (online or at the university premises, depending on the situation in the country).

COURSE FEE: Rs. 60,000/- (sixty thousand rupees only)

The first instalment of Rs. 35,000/- should be made at the time of registration and the second instalment of Rs. 25,000/- should be made within three months from registration.

MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Passing the G.C.E. (A/L) exam
or equivalent qualifications or professional experience of 10 years, as required

SELECTION CRITERIA: Passing the interview conducted by the Department

COMMENCEMENT: August 2022

APPLICATION FEE: Rs.750/= should be paid to the account 055-100110667549 of the University of Kelaniya, from any branch of People's Bank, indicating "Diploma in translation and Interpretation-2022".

OBTAINING THE APPLICATION: A scanned copy of the receipt obtained by the payment of the application fee should be emailed to drti@kln.ac.lk. The application and relevant Google form will be sent by the Department as the reply.

SUBMITTING THE APPLICATION: The Google form should be submitted online and the duly filled application form should be sent under registered cover to reach "Coordinator, Diploma in Translation and Interpretation, Department of Linguistics, University of Kelaniya, Kelaniya" on or before 24.06.2022, indicating "Application of Diploma in Translation and Interpretation - 2022" at the top left hand corner of the envelope.

Copy of the birth certificate, copy of the NIC, copy of the A/L result sheet, and the original bank receipt should also be attached to the application.



Incomplete or delayed applications could be rejected as the number of admissions is limited. Priority will be given to the order in which applications are received.
