01. Recruitment of Apprentices

Minimum qualifications

- Applicants should have passed the G.C.E. (O/L) examination in six subjects inclusive of Sinhala and Mathematics i. with a minimum of 02 credit passes at one sitting.
- ii. Applicants should be over 18 years and below 35 years of age and should be mentally and physically fit in health.

02. Method of Recruitment for Training

- i. 20 resident and 20 non-resident students will be recruited.
- In case of the number of applicants exceed the number of that could be admitted, those with minimum qualifications should face an interview.
- ii. Applicants who obtain highest marks will be recruited for the course.

03. How to forward applications :

- ii. Application forms should be perfected in English language and duly completed forms should be sent by registered post to reach office of the Provincial Director, Department of Animal Production and Health (Western Province), Welisara, Ragama.

- iv. Closing date of receiving applications will be 15th May 2023.

04. Specific Conditions:

- i. The training course will be conducted in Sinhala medium
- ii. All expenses for the studies of the course will be borne by the Western Provincial Council and hostel facilities too will be provided by the training institute. Nevertheless, food, physical and other personal expenses during the training period should be borne by the trainees themselves.
- iii. Selected trainees should enter into an agreement to the effect that they will adhere to the discipline and code of ethics during the training period and successfully complete the training session.
- iv. If the trainee withdraw from the training before the end of the term, he or she is bound to repay the cost borne by the Western Provincial Council and should enter into a security bond to the effect.
- v. A NVQ- Level 04 certificate will be issued by the institute for those apprentices who pass the written and practical tests at the end of the training period and the department or the training institute is not bound to provide jobs relevant to the training.
- vi. Applicants should have not been registered for any other course.
