and

- possess a Master's Degree in any of the above fields from a recognised university along with a minimum of 10 years of experience in the relevant field at senior managerial level;

or

possess a Bachelor's Degree with a Class in Finance, Economics, Accountancy, Business Administration, Management, Law or Statistics from a recognised university or be an Attorney-at-Law or a member of a recognised professional institution in any of the above fields along with a minimum of 20 years of experience in the relevant field at senior managerial level and managerial level.

- Possess a good command of English and Sinhala Languages, strong analytical and writing skills, excellent presentation skills and be computer literate.

The position offers an excellent working environment which is professional, challenging and intellectually stimulating with an attractive remuneration package in keeping with the qualifications and experience of the successful candidate.
