# BASIC EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Should possess Three (03) Simple Passes at the G.C.E (A/L) Examination and 30% marks for the Common General Test with "Yes" for university admission in one (01) sitting and not more than in three (03) attempts
- Those who have sat for G.C.E (A/L) in the year 2021 may also apply on pending results

• Passed minimum of eight (08) subjects with five (05) Credit Passes (C) in one sitting not more than two (02) attempts and compulsory Credit (C) Passes for English, Mathematics, Science and Sinhala or Tamil at G.C.E (O/L) examination. The candidates who have obtained a simple pass (S) for English at GCE (O/L) will be considered if they possess Credit Pass (C) for English subject at GCE (A/L) examination or possess any NVQ Level - 4 or above diploma/Degree in English medium awarded by a UGC recognized university/institute (NVQ level certificate must be produced)

 An equivalent result obtained at international examinations (such as Pearson/Edexcel, GCSE, GCE and Cambridge) may also be considered with the acceptence of the Department of Examination, Sri Lanka as equivalents to G.C.E (O/L) and G.C.E (A/L) (Including the compulsory subjects).

### OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

Sports and any other achievement in international and national level and proficiency in languages other than Sinhala & English will be considered as added qualifications.
